My thanks to the three club members (and one of them brought three friends) who attended the Darien Library reception. I wish that it had been closer to home because I know others wanted to attend but found the distance a bit daunting.

My experience with the Darien Library in CT suggests that there are other public places such as our local libraries, historical associations, banks, senior residences or community centers, etc., which might be open to photo shows. I encourage members to try to get such shows-- for their own solo shows, or perhaps for our club. Ask--and you might receive.

Another thing I've learned is that one show can lead to another. Someone who saw the Darien Library show wants me to do one in June at his senior residence right nearby. Unlike the Library, which takes a 20% commission and did not pay for the reception, the residence has no commission and will do everything for the reception, plus print up the cards! Believe me, this was an offer I couldn't refuse!

Field Trip to the Bronx Zoo
